International nuclear disarmament can be brought about only by diplomacy and negotiation, not by military action. All nations, not just Iraq, must stick to United Nations resolutions and international treaties.

There are no challenges to Israel's possession of nuclear weapons, nor are **Britain and the United States** making any effort to disarm their own arsenal of weapons of mass destruction. The US will not even allow UN chemical weapons inspectors into their country, so their hypocrisy on the issue of Iraq is unbelievable. And let's not forget, that the US is the only country to have used a nuclear weapon (in Hiroshima and Nagasaki), the only country to have bombed over 20 other countries since the second world war, has refused to ratify the International Criminal Court, among many other travesties of justice. Who is the biggest threat to world peace?

The only reason for attacking Iraq, as opposed to any other evil dictatorship in the world has got to be to gain control of the rich oil reserves. To pretend

otherwise is condescending towards the intelligence of the British population.
