



NOTICE TO BICYCLISTS



IT IS ILLEGAL TO RIDE A BICYCLE IN A PROCESSION ON THE PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN NEW YORK CITY IF A PERMIT FOR THE PROCESSION HAS NOT BEEN ISSUED BY THE NEW YORK CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT.

BICYCLISTS ARE SUBJECT TO THE SAME RULES OF THE ROAD APPLICABLE TO MOTOR VEHICLES, INCLUDING: OBEDIENCE TO ALL OFFICIAL GOVERNMENTAL SIGNS, SIGNALS, MARKINGS, AND OTHER DEVICES ERECTED FOR THE PURPOSE OF REGULATING, WARNING OR GUIDING TRAFFIC.

BICYCLISTS MAY NOT RIDE ON SIDEWALKS, EXPRESSWAYS, DRIVES, HIGHWAYS, INTERSTATE ROUTES, BRIDGES, TUNNELS AND THRUWAYS.

BICYCLISTS MUST RIDE IN USABLE BICYCLE LANES OR NEAR THE CURB OR EDGE OF THE ROADWAY, AND NOT RIDE MORE THAN TWO ABBREAST.

BICYCLISTS MAY NOT IMPEDE PEDESTRIAN OR VEHICULAR TRAFFIC. INTENTIONALLY IMPEDING GOVERNMENTAL AND EMERGENCY VEHICLES IS A SERIOUS OFFENSE.

VIOLATORS OF THE FOREGOING ARE SUBJECT TO ARREST AND BICYCLE SEIZURE.

ATTENTION BICYCLISTS



THE NEW YORK CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT ASKS FOR YOUR COOPERATION IN MAKING TONIGHT'S RIDE A SAFE EVENT. WE ASK THAT YOU FOLLOW THE ROUTE SET FORTH BELOW, AND THAT YOU NOT ALLOW THE GROUP TO BECOME TOO "STRETCHED OUT," SO AS TO MINIMIZE THE INTERFERENCE WITH EMERGENCY VEHICLES AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC. TO THIS END, YOU MAY BE DIRECTED BY POLICE OFFICERS AT VARIOUS POINTS ON THE ROUTE TO TEMPORARILY STOP FOR OTHERS IN THE RIDE TO "CATCH UP."

ROUTE

Leave Union Square Park at the northeast end near 17th Street and travel northbound on Park Avenue to 55th Street, left turn (west) on 55th Street to Fifth Avenue, left turn (south) on Fifth Avenue to Broadway, south on Broadway back to Union Square Park.

WE ASK THAT YOU DO NOT DEVIATE FROM THIS ROUTE. IF YOU DO NOT FOLLOW THIS ROUTE YOU MUST FOLLOW ALL TRAFFIC RULES, INCLUDING THOSE LISTED BELOW. IF YOU WISH TO LEAVE THE ROUTE, PLEASE DISMOUNT YOUR BICYCLE AND WALK AWAY FROM THE ROUTE. BICYCLISTS WHO DO NOT FOLLOW THE ABOVE ROUTE AND ALL TRAFFIC RULES, INCLUDING THOSE LISTED BELOW, ARE SUBJECT TO ARREST.

TRAFFIC RULES

- IT IS ILLEGAL TO PARTICIPATE IN A PROCESSION ON THE PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN NEW YORK CITY IF A PERMIT FOR THE PROCESSION HAS NOT BEEN ISSUED BY THE NEW YORK CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT.
- BICYCLISTS ARE SUBJECT TO THE SAME RULES OF THE ROAD APPLICABLE TO MOTOR VEHICLES, INCLUDING: OBEDIENCE TO ALL OFFICIAL GOVERNMENTAL SIGNS, SIGNALS, MARKINGS, AND OTHER DEVICES ERECTED FOR THE PURPOSE OF REGULATING, WARNING OR GUIDING TRAFFIC.
- BICYCLISTS MAY NOT RIDE ON SIDEWALKS, EXPRESSWAYS, DRIVES, HIGHWAYS, INTERSTATE ROUTES, BRIDGES, TUNNELS AND THRUWAYS.
- BICYCLISTS MUST RIDE IN USABLE BICYCLE LANES OR NEAR THE CURB OR EDGE OF THE ROADWAY.
- BICYCLISTS MAY NOT IMPEDE PEDESTRIAN OR VEHICULAR TRAFFIC. INTENTIONALLY IMPEDING TRAFFIC, ESPECIALLY EMERGENCY VEHICLES, IS A SERIOUS OFFENSE.
- INDIVIDUALS LEAVING BICYCLES LEFT UNATTENDED IN A PUBLIC PLACE, INCLUDING THOSE LOCKED TO STREET FIXTURES, ARE IN VIOLATION OF NYC ADMINISTRATIVE CODE § 16-122. A SUMMONS MAY BE ISSUED AND THE BICYCLE MAY BE REMOVED.

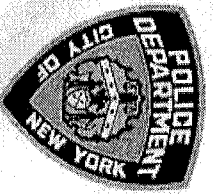
