

# Celebration of Solidarity with the Pitstop 5



**What:** On February 3rd 2003, Karen Fallon, Deirdre Clancy, Nuin Dunlop, Ciaran O'Reilly and Damien Moran **nonviolently disabled a U.S. Navy war plane at Shannon Airport, Co. Clare** in Ireland. 10,000 U.S. troops a month continue to commute through Shannon Airport on their way to Iraq. The Irish Government has transformed a civilian airport into a militarised pitstop for the U.S. war machine. The Pit Stop Ploughshares 5 will go to trial in Dublin on Monday, October 24th.

As the occupation of Iraq drags on, we are celebrating those who have taken a courageous stand against the war. Join us to show your support for the Pitstop 5. **Bring a song, a poem or a drink.** There will also be an opportunity to support the travel costs of witnesses for the Pitstop trial and other associated expenses.
