

On Tuesday 27th November, renowned filmmaker Ken Loach (The Wind That Shakes The Barley, Sweet Sixteen, Kes) is coming to Crawley to show and talk about his new film "It's a Free World...". This film is a drama about a single mother, showing the reality of living and working in the UK as a so-called illegal immigrant.

Ken Loach will be joined in a post-film discussion by a former Tinsley House detainee and "failed" asylum seeker from the Democratic Republic of Congo, and an activist from the No Border network who organised a protest camp near Crawley in September.

Tinsley House is an immigration detention centre for 126 people at Gatwick airport. A much larger centre, Brook House, is currently under construction nearby. Entry to the film and discussion is free-of-
