#### **Profiting from Climate Change**

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E.ON claim that their proposed new coal power station will be 'Carbon Capture Ready'. However the process of carbon capture has yet to be demonstrated to work on a commercial scale. Even if carbon capture should be proven to work at some point in the future, there is no legal requirement or deadline for adding the (very expensive) carbon capture technology.

Despite the hype from E.ON, coal is still the dirtiest power source, and 'clean coal' is little more than a distraction from the real solutions to climate change: reducing consumption, and increasing the amount of power generated from renewable sources.

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E.ON Today will undoubtedly be promoting their green credentials. However in the UK E.ON's portfolio accounts for just 2% of energy generated, with coal accounting for 61%. While investment in renewables is to be applauded. new power capacity from renewables should go along-side a reduction in fossil fuel use not an increase!



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
