Every year:

- £25 billion is lost to tax avoidance by very wealthy individuals and companies
- Total Tax Gap (avoided/evaded) £120 billion
- £2.8 billion spent by Government on private consultants
- £3 billion could be raised by taxing big financial transactions

The last Government spent billions bailing out banks and big business instead of:

- regulating the city
- taking banking, insurance & mortgage industries into public ownership for the benefit of all

The disabled, the poor, the elderly and the young will bear the brunt of the cuts.

- Student fees to TREBLE
- A million JOBS lost in the private and public sectors
- Wage freezes
- Pay cuts
